VOLLEYBALL - WOMEN

The United States women's volleyball team, highly conditioned and playing its best style, won all five of its matches by 3-0 scores and easily outdistanced the field for the gold medal. Captain Jane Ward, a 1964 Olympian as well as a member of the 1959 and 1963 Pan-American teams, paced the triumphs.

The championship was the USA's first, after having placed second three times, to Mexico in 1955 and to Brazil in 1959 and 1963.

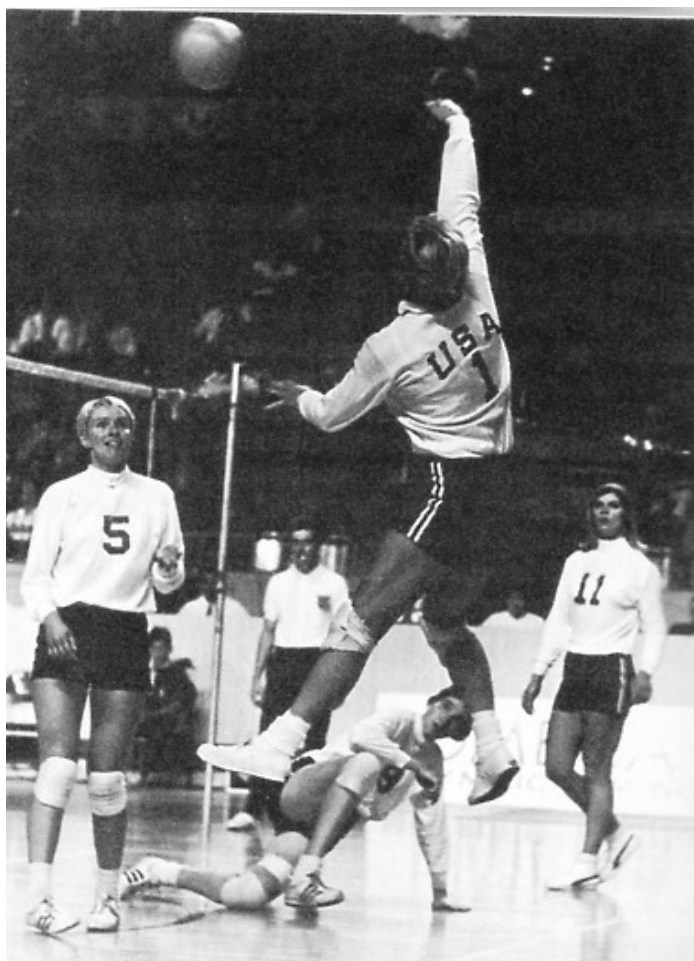
